Why EV Charging at Multifamily Properties?

EV charging at home is the most convenient and cost effective charging option for EV drivers, but people living in multifamily housing face barriers to accessing home charging. As EV adoption grows exponentially in the coming years, multifamily residents will expect EV charging if the property offers parking on site.

According to the National Multifamily Housing Council, more than 40 million apartment renters live in the nation's nearly 23 million apartment homes. About three-quarters of apartment households have at least one vehicle. In addition, 54% of apartments are situated in larger communities with over 100 units, offering a prime opportunity for scaling EV charging solutions*.
